Business

- **Jodi Kleinert—Registrar** mentioned that paperwork for League registration is completed. A check needs to be cut to EPYSA for Rec Registration.

- **Annette Moshgat—Concessions**

--Free Pizza from Pizza Town is being provided for us to sell during the season at the concession stand

--Washington Fire Company has offered to do a Chicken BBQ Fundraiser with us. We would earn \$1 per meal and would need to guarantee 300 dinners. We're going to graciously decline their offer.

--A State Farm Insurance Agent has provided 4 cases of water—with his name and contact information. The water is to be given away. We don't want to compete with our concession stand, so the water will be provided for concession stand volunteers.

--This past week has been the 1st full week of the concession stand being open for practices. As is typical, Annette has had some problems with people not following through on their volunteer commitments, but it hasn't been too much of a problem because volume has been slow. Only making \$30/night at Fisher. Will evaluate to see if this is worth continuing.

--A complaint was raised about the concession stand at Friendship being cluttered with bottles and equipment from the High School Boys Team. Neil will discuss this with Tony.

--Mike still needs specifics about Rec schedules—Annette will get that information to him.

--Neil is going to connect with Tony re: U-6 Schedules and Coaches as it relates to pictures and then get that information to Mike.

- **Web Master**—Neil talked about Shane's role as web master. He commended Shane on the excellent job he has been doing, and mentioned that we've been exploring options on how to handle that position in the future.

- **Sharon Newcomer—Uniform Coordinator**

--Travel uniforms have been distributed. All Rec Uniforms will have been delivered by Saturday (9/1).

- **Miscellaneous Items...**

--Background checks—EPYSA has provided background checks to us at the cost of \$3.50/person.

--Grading and seeding of new fields in new development (name escapes me)—The township is behind on grading and seeding of this area.

--We've worked out the kinks for the mowing schedule with the township so we can avoid the problems like we had just prior to SoccerFest.

--SoccerFest—Day was very hot. However, went well. Tony's kids did a great job leading the stations. There were some glitches related to clean up. There was some discussion of the value of SoccerFest and the recommendation that even though some things went wrong, this is an important day for Rec Soccer. Having said that, we recognize that SoccerFest can't fall on several people. We need more volunteers for that day.

--Fund-raiser—The cards were distributed and we emphasized the need for teams to participate in this as much as possible.

--Checks for referee fees were delivered to the Travel Coaches.
